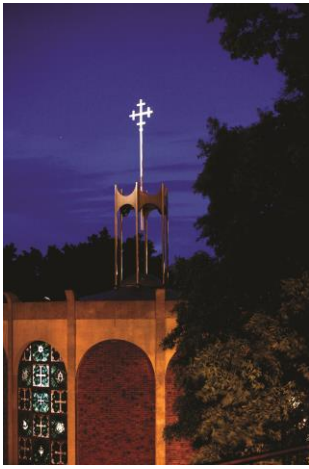

United Methodist Ministerial Student Tuition Assistance provide tuition assistance to students called of God and committed to ordination and pastoral ministry in the local church. Recipients participate in the Programs for Ministry through the Office of Church Relations including ministry internships and covenant partnerships, and work toward ordination requirements.
