**Policy Abstract** – Birmingham-Southern College will provide classroom and lab computers for existing classroom and lab environments and refresh this equipment on a regular cycle.

- Introduction/Background Official classroom instruction will be conducted using College provided computer technology. Therefore, computers will be refreshed on an on-going basis as deemed appropriate.
- 2. **Purpose** As classroom and computer lab instruction continues it is necessary to manage the computer equipment provided in accordance with best practices.
- 3. Applicable Regulations SACSCOC, Principles of Accreditation 2018

## 4. Policy Statement -

- Standard PC computer equipment provided by the College will be used to furnish
  computer classrooms and labs. Exceptions may be allowed, but only for an occurrence
  where software applications will not run on a PC. In these cases justification must be
  provided that a PC will not adequately perform the task thus requiring something other
  than a PC.
- An annual review of College provided technology will be conducted by Information
  Technology staff during the budget process. In this review a determination will be made
  as to which equipment will be refreshed.
- 5. **Details** –The guidelines used are to refresh classroom and classroom lab computers on a 4-year cycle. In other words, classroom and classroom lab computers are to be refreshed during the time following the 4<sup>th</sup> year of use. Teaching and research labs will be refreshed with available equipment as is deemed appropriate. Connectivity to scientific instruments in teaching and research lab settings often dictates the timing of the replacement of this equipment. Every effort will be made to keep teaching and research labs on a rotation of less than 8 year old computer equipment.
  - Classrooms and labs are separated into the following categories

- 1. PC
  - a. Classrooms
  - b. Classroom Labs
  - c. Teaching Labs
  - d. Research Labs
- 2. Mac
  - a. Classrooms
  - b. Classroom Labs
- All PC classrooms and labs will be maintained by the Information Technology Helpdesk group to keep the equipment in good working order.
- All Mac classroom and classroom labs will be maintained by the departments using them.
