   Allocation of space will be determined by the Director of the Library and the Provost.
- Purpose To clarify issues involving the provision of computing/printing availability, network (including the Internet) and software application access, and technology support.

Each emeriti faculty will retain a Birmingham-Southern College network account and email address that is linked to that account. Full access is provided to all software applications for which the College maintains a campus license agreement on campusowned equipment.

- 5. Details Emeriti faculty will request and receive support from IT for professional activities in the same manner as other College constituents. The Help Desk is available via web access, e-mail and X4849 and will accept requests during normal business hours. Priority will be given to active faculty, staff and student needs with emeriti faculty receiving assistance as time permits. Any exceptions to the elements of this policy must be authorized by the Vice President for IT.
